Code of practice for CUCC experienced cavers

CUCC safety-critical tackle

Ensure that jammers and Stops are left shut when not in use in the cave; do not incorrectly load metalwork. Do not chain unchecked rope.

SRT kits and metalwork must be hung up to dry after each trip and not left wet inside bags.

For CUCC trips the following procedures shall be taken:

- For introductory trips a trip leader will be chosen of sufficient experience to lead the trip, who must be confident of the abilities and experience of the members of the party to safely undertake the trip, as well as being confident that adequate supplies and tackle have been taken. A seconder will normally also be chosen who is able to lead the trip should the leader get into difficulties. The ratio of novices to experienced
