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Day 1 Khiva – Bukhara

- Breakfast
- Depart by road on to Bukhara, (510 km, 5,5 hours drive).
- Afternoon- arrive in Bukhara.
- Check in.
- Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 2 Bukhara

- Breakfast
- Full day walking tour of Bukhara

1. Visit to the 2000 year-old Fortress Ark where Emirs once lived.
2. Poi-Kalon, or "Pedestal of the Great", the heart and focal point of all Bukhara
3. The Ismail Samani Mausoleum (early 10th century)
4. Chashma Ayub - the Spring of Job, where according to the old Testament, Job caused water to gush from the desert.
 - Magoki - Attori mosque (12th century)
 - Medressahs of Ulug-Bek and Abdul-Aziz Khan.
 - Lyabi-Khaus otherwise known as The Shore of the Pool, an architectural complex consisting of the 16th century medrassah and a

Day 3 Bukhara – Samarkand

- Breakfast
- Drive to legendary Samarkand (270 km, 3,5 hours to drive), the grand capital of the emperor Tamerlane.
- Upon arrival in Samarkand, transfer to the hotel.
- Drive to the actual site of the ancient city of Afrosiab to visit the Afrosiab Museum with its excellent collection of treasures from the site.
- Overnight in Samarkand.

Day 4 Samarkand

- Breakfast
- Morning - Visit the great central square of Samarkand, the Registan.
- Gur-Emir, where Tamerlane is buried
- Bibi-Khanum Mosque and the nearby market.
- Shakhi -Zinda ensemble of the Mausoleums. This unusual necropolis has monuments of the 14th and 15th centuries, reflecting the development of the monumental art and architecture of the Timurid dynasty.
- Overnight in Samarkand.

Day 5 Samarkand –Tashkent

- Breakfast
- Morning - depart from Samarkand to Tashkent (350 km, 4 hours to drive).
- Arrival in Tashkent by lunch time.
- Visit the State Art Museum to see old Turkestan-Zoroastrian artifacts, 1,000-year-old Buddhist statues, royal furnishings and 20th century applied art including silk-on-cotton suzani (finely embroidered dowry hangings) and other craft work.
- Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 6 Departure from Tashkent

Morning transfer to the airport for the flight home.
