

Pre-Conference 6 day tour in Uzbekistan

(Tashkent, Samarkand, Bukhara, Khiva)

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Tour cost is:

for 1 pax – 1148 US dollars

for the group of 2 pax - 634 US dollars per person + 30 US dollars per person for single supplement

Day 1 Tashkent

- Arrival in Tashkent.
- Transfer to the hotel for one night.

Day 2 Tashkent – Samarkand

- After breakfast depart by road to legendary Samarkand, the grand capital of the emperor Tamerlane. The road goes through Tashkent, Sirdarya regions and mountainous countryside of Jizzah region of Uzbekistan (beautiful photo opportunities).
- Check into the hotel.
- Then drive to the actual site of the ancient city of Afrosiab to visit the Afrosiab Museum with its excellent collection of treasures from the site.
- Overnight in Samarkand.

Day 3 Samarkand

- Morning - visit the great central square of Samarkand, the Reghistan.
- Continue to Gur-Emir, where Tamerlane is buried
- Bibi-Khanum Mosque
- Nearby Local Market.
- After lunch visit Shaki -Zinda ensemble of the Mausoleums. This unusual necropolis has monuments of the 14th and 15th centuries, reflecting the development of the monumental art and architecture of the Timurid dynasty.
- Overnight in Samarkand.

Day 4 Samarkand – Bukhara

- After breakfast we'll drive on to holy Bukhara making a stop in Gizhduvan to visit the most important ceramic center of Bukhara region.
- Continue drive on to Bukhara. Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 5 Bukhara

- After breakfast we'll start full day walking tour of Bukhara to include a visit to the 2000 year-old Fortress Ark where Emirs once lived.
- Visit Poi-Kalon, or "Pedestal of the Great", the heart and focal point of all Bukhara
- The Ismail Samani Mausoleum, dating from the early 10th century
- Chashma Ayub - the Spring of Job, where according to the old Testament, Job caused water to gush from the desert.
- After lunch continue sightseeing to Magoki - Attori mosque, dating from 12th century
- Medressahs of Ulug-Bek and Abdul-Aziz Khan.
- Lyabi-Khaus also known as The Shore of the Pool, an architectural complex consisting of the 16th century medrassah and a mosque and the nearby dome covered markets.

Day 6 Bukhara – Khiva

- After breakfast depart by road to Khiva, the most intact and remote city in Uzbekistan (510 km, 5,5 hours to drive).
