11 km

18 km

Saturday 3rd February

Bury St Edmunds

18 km

There is time to walk 18km, but attendant ramblers may prefer to spend some time exploring Bury St Edmunds. Out: Train at 1230 to Bury, arriving 1313.

Back: Train at 1728 from Bury to Cambridge at 1813.

Sunday 11th February

Stretham and Ely

22 km

Come and see the famous fenland landscapes of North Cambridgshire.

Out: Cambus 109 at 1015 to Stretham, arriving 1048.

Back: Cambus 109 at 1737 from Ely to Cambridge, arriving 1822.

Saturday 17th February

Fulbourn to Balsham

11 km

This walk follow the ancient earth-work defense called Fleam Dyke.

Out: Premier coach 40/44 at 1240 to Fulbourn, arriving 1307.

Back: Premier coach 40/44 at 1625 from Balsham to Cambridge, arriving 1700.

Sunday 25th February

Royston to Cambridge

27 km

This should be a rewarding ramble - please join-in!

Out: Train at 0900 to Royston, arrive 0920.

Back: Foot to Cambridge, arriving ...

Saturday 3rd March

Cambridge to Waterbeach

8 km

After last weeks effort, this is a leisurely river-side stroll.

Out: Meet at the Pike and Eel in Chesterton at 1300.

Back: Cambus 124 at 1517 from Waterbeach to Cambridge, arriving 1540.

Sunday 11th March

St Ives to Huntingdon

20 km

Out: Cambus 151 at 1000 to St Ives, arriving 1016.

Back: Cambus 151 at 1710 from Huntingdon to Cambridge, arriving 1815.
